Investment in Pakistan's Port Infrastructure



August 2024: Maersk to invest \$2bn in Pakistan's port infrastructure:

Maersk, a leading Danish shipping company, has announced a substantial investment of \$2 billion in Pakistan's port and transport infrastructure over the next two years. Commenting on the development, Qaiser Ahmed Sheikh highlighted Karachi's potential to increase exports, noting that the Ministry of Maritime Affairs is working to create a favorable business environment for the country's trade community.

In related news, last month, Khurram Aziz Khan, CEO of Abu Dhabi Ports Pakistan, announced a \$250 million investment in Karachi Port over the next decade. During a meeting with Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, Khan and his delegation outlined plans for a \$130 million investment in a multipurpose terminal at Karachi Port, expected to be completed within two years. The upgrade will include automated gates, an expanded berth, a crane rail track, and other essential infrastructure improvements.

Pakistan eyes new export markets in Afghanistan, Central Asia

July 2024:

Pakistan's exports have historically been inclined toward western economies, China and Gulf Cooperation Council region. Pakistan now seeks to explore new export markets including the landlocked Central Asian Republics, South African region.

Pakistani Minister for Commerce Jam Kamal Khan chaired a meeting in Islamabad on exploring new export markets, saying the potential for trade with Afghanistan and Central Asia could be enhanced by addressing "political and connectivity challenges." Pakistan's exports to five Central Asian countries, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan, rose by 21.17 percent to \$158.07 million in July-February 2024 from \$130.45 million in the same period the previous year.

Pakistan Strengthens Trade Ties with Global Partners at Major Investment Forum

A significant trade and investment forum recently brought together over 60 leading Pakistani companies and more than 100 companies from the host country. The event focused on enhancing bilateral trade, with Pakistan highlighting key exports such as leather garments, textiles, surgical instruments, rice, and sports goods. Port Link was actively represented by Mr. Ajaz Ali, Business Head – Afghanistan and CIS Trade, who attended the forum to explore new collaboration opportunities in trade, energy, and agriculture.


